### How the Fundraiser Works:

- Each pack of premium cashews costs \$30.
- Our school receives \$5 of the profit from every pack sold, with proceeds going directly toward **our worthy student fund**. We have set our goal to \$25,000 with a donor match dollar for dollar up to \$25,000. **So now our giving doubles!**
